Approval of agenda - skipped

- 1) Voting in of new officers:
  - a. Bradwin – Chronicler – unanimous
  - b. Strato – Chatelaine – unanimous
  - c. Cairn – Herald – unanimous

Call for deputies (including deputy Seneschal!)

Tarius raises the question: is bilingualism a requirement for the Seneschal / deputy Seneschal(s)? Jordan confirms there is no bilingual requirement, and anyone interested should feel free to speak up whether they speak only English, only French, or both.

- 2) Financial update from the Exchequer :
  - a. Current bank balance : \$4,074.88
    - i. Owe \$977.13 to Dragonet
    - ii. Total IDD funds : \$3,097.75
  - b. BIA breakdown :
    - i. \$1189 (gate) - \$60 NMS - \$949.04 expenses = \$179.96 profit.

ii. Flowers & strawberries NSRTF fundraiser : \$40 profit

As a side note, Tadea mentions that more fundraising will happen at Crown. Anyone who has ideas should let her know.

3) Crown update :

- a. 21 reservations & 89 cabin reservations to date
- b. There is a site visit scheduled for April 17th (pending confirmation of site owner availability by Jordan). This visit is to determine how we will use the site facilities (which areas, buildings, etc...) Camilla would like/need to have at least the following people accompany her :
  - i. A driver
  - ii. Someone (s) from kitchen staff
  - iii. Someone (s) who will be involved in the set-up
- c. Camilla is looking for someone to help organize the marshals and list poles. Angus may be able to help, he will confirm in the near future
- d. Heralds will be organized by Kingdom, but anyone interested in helping out as a herald, runner, etc...should contact Camilla so that she can get them in touch with the right people.
- e. Issue of "waterbearers" is raised – do we want to supply a staff for this given the recent ban on official waterbearing? This point will be reviewed by Curia.
- f. Jeanne will be coordinating the service at feast, interested volunteers should contact her
- g. Site tokens and list posts (enough for 6-8 lists) are taken care of
- h. There will be a Queen's Tea, which will probably be funded with the sideboard budget. Camilla will be looking for volunteers to help with the set-up/take down of the Tea. If it looks like we will need additional funds that have not already been included in the expense total, Camilla will advise Curia ASAP.
- i. There will be a workday scheduled for Sunday May 2<sup>nd</sup> (again pending Jordan's confirmation with the site owner). The workday will be to clean and set up the required spaces, and possibly set up additional items (like the list posts) if possible. To be confirmed by Jordan.
- j. Jeanne requests that anyone currently holding on to Baronial banners please contact her.
- k. Camilla is looking into creating an "event quartermaster" position so that one person will be able to keep a control list for the items obtained from the Barony and individuals.
- l. Cosmano is the head of the Kitchen Staff. He is requesting volunteers, both for feast- and dayboard-related activities. He mentions that Kitchen Staff has some truly excellent SCA cooks planning a menu of dishes that have already been hits at other events, and it will be a wonderful opportunity for those wishing to see SCA large-scale cooking at its best.

4) Varia

- a. Tadea announces that the rules for the 2011 A&S Championship will be posted soon. They will involve a point-accumulation system based on participation in A&S activities all year long
- b. Cosmano announces that the 2011 Rapier Championship rules will be similar, involving a year-long participation in special Rapier activities. Details will be coming soon.
- c. Cosmano raises the point of why volunteering is so important in the SCA, as lack of new volunteers can easily lead to burn-out among those who are currently carrying the burden. Cairn adds that volunteering is a serious commitment, and that if someone volunteers for a job they should be prepared to meet the obligations of that job as best they can. Volunteers who say they'll help and then don't do anything are not looked upon kindly. Jordan lends her support to both statements.
- d. Jeanne brings up the next schola – possible date: Monday May 31<sup>st</sup>. To be discussed on the list. Jeanne also mentions that this weekend Boisé Ardent is holding some weaving classes for anyone who is interested.

5) 8:25pm – a few words from His Excellency (not an official court)

- a. His Excellency wishes the populace to be aware that he will be fighting in the spring Crown Tournament, although he does not expect to make it to the finals
- b. His Excellency will be attending GNEW this year, and wishes to know if anyone has been approached to take sides yet. If not, he asks that whoever is going make themselves known so that we can make a strong baronial showing
- c. This will be the last month of indoor practice for the heavy fighters. April will see the return of practice in Girouard Park.
- d. His Excellency announces “officially” that he will be stepping down. The process has already begun; Svana from Boisé Ardent will be helping Jordan to coordinate the polling with Kingdom. Jordan will send out an e-mail detailing the proceedings so that all Baronial citizens will be up to date on the timelines and specific process involved. Anyone who has any questions about the polling may address them to His Excellency or Jordan.
